**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE REVISED VISION, MISSION, AND CORE VALUES
AND TO ENDORSE THE NEW STRATEGIC PLAN, *BUILDING ON A STRONG
FOUNDATION—NJIT 2025***

WHEREAS, the NJIT community has engaged in a robust and inclusive strategic planning process for the last two years, and

WHEREAS, this process began at the Board of Trustees retreat in June of 2017, and

WHEREAS, this plan has undergone extensive community and Board review, and

WHEREAS, the revision of the Vision, Mission, and Core Values were part of this process, and

WHEREAS, the current strategic plan, *2020 Vision*, concludes on June 30, 2020, and

WHEREAS, a strategic plan is required by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education.
